

The course of a minimum of 12 weeks duration is aimed at providing an excellent basis of Spanish language and culture. 

EXAM PREPARATION COURSES

DELE EXAM PREPARATION

This course prepares for the DELE exam, the “Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera”. DELE is the official certificate to accredit competence in the Spanish language, issued by the Cervantes Institute on behalf of the Spanish Ministry for Education. There are three levels: Inicial (corresponding to level B1 of the European Framework), Intermedio (B1) and Superior (C2). CLIC is an accredited centre of the Cervantes Institute.

The programme consists of General Spanish instruction plus additional lessons of specific training in exam strategies and techniques based on authentic material and mock exams. Preparation courses are available for the May, August and November exams.



The exams are held here in Seville on the last day of class. The DELE Preparation Course is offered in two varieties:

DELE CRASH Course 120

This four week course consists of 20 lessons per week in General Spanish plus 10 weekly lessons of specific exam preparation, strategies and techniques.

DELE INTENSIVE Course 260

This ten week course consists of 20 lessons per week in General Spanish plus 6 weekly lessons of specific exam preparation, strategies and techniques.

BUSINESS SPANISH (Chamber of Commerce of Madrid)

CLIC IH is an officially accredited examination centre for the Madrid Chamber of Commerce. This four week course prepares for the exam “Certificado Superior de la Cámara de Comercio de Madrid”, which is held at CLIC on the last day of the course. The course consists of 20 weekly lessons of General Spanish combined with 10 lessons of Business Spanish. Students will learn the most practical aspects of Spanish business life; topics included in this course are business correspondence, verbal negotiation, socio-political geography as well as the state of the Spanish economy in the Hispanic and International markets. The ideal course for professionals working in the import and export trade or those who wish to work in a Spanish speaking country and need to certify their business language competence.





SPANISH EDUCATION PROGRAMME

A unique opportunity to broaden young people's education and cultural awareness

This special formula consists of 6 weeks of General Intensive Spanish plus 12 weeks of Spanish High School. We prepare the student with counselling and orientation, and organize the high school placement. During the high school visit the student receives a weekly tutorial at CLIC to help with any doubts related to his class work or language matters. Students live in selected, caring Spanish host families, single room with full board. Also included is the airport transfer upon arrival and departure.

An excellent way to experience a Spanish high school, acquire a profound knowledge of the language in many different areas and make friendships which may last for life.

SPANISH AND FLAMENCO

Learn Spanish and get an insight into Spain's most fascinating cultural legacy: Flamenco music and dance

You will receive theoretical and practical instruction in a renowned and professional Flamenco academy and take back home an essential feature of Spanish culture. The course consists of 20 weekly lessons of General Spanish in the mornings combined with 4 hours per week of Flamenco dance lessons in the afternoon. Additional private guitar, singing or Flamenco percussion lessons can also be arranged.

SPANISH PLUS WORK EXPERIENCE

Learn Spanish, acquire work experience and enlarge your professional horizons

The Spanish Plus Work Experience is intended to allow students from EU countries to gain some work experience and at the same time benefit from learning the language where it is spoken.

The course can last for between 2 to 4 weeks of a General Spanish Intensive course plus 8 to 20 weeks of work experience. Unpaid work placements are offered in different areas and business sectors in Seville; paid work placements in the hotel sector in Southern Spain. The programme includes counselling and guidance throughout the stay, preparation of CV, selection of work placement, interview, certificate of attendance.

MASTER CLASS FOR THE OVER FIFTIES

A practical Spanish and special cultural programme

This course is designed for students over 50. Among the participants we can find teachers, academics, those who spend part of the year or their holidays in Spain.

Classes are in small groups with the emphasis on oral expression, as well as social and cultural aspects rather than grammar analysis and written skills. The teachers who impart this course are conscious of the specific needs of the students as well as their different rhythm of learning and the importance of special emphasis on culture (festivals and traditions, history and literature and the Spanish life style). The programme includes Seville airport or train station transfer upon arrival, 20 Spanish classes per week, welcome drink and cultural activities four days a week. Entrance tickets to the museums and monuments are included as well as a concert or theatre evening, a meal with the teacher and a Saturday full day excursion.





CULTURAL AND LEISURE PROGRAMME

Learning a new language also means learning about a different way of life and culture

Seville is the ideal place to experience the Spanish way of life due to the wide range of cultural activities that the city can provide. CLIC IH offers its students a daily programme of activities to discover the city and its pastimes. This varied programme helps students to fit into their new lifestyle in addition to the language classes they receive. The vast majority of activities are free.

IN-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Four free weekly optional classes (included in the 20+4 or 30+4 courses) for students given by teachers, which include conferences and talks as well as exhibitions organised by the school's collaborators.

Example: Spanish history, art history, phonetics, cinema, Spanish cookery classes, Sevillana dance classes.

Other activities: Salsa classes and wine tasting.

OFF-SITE ACTIVITIES

Guided visits to different monuments and museums in the city by our teachers. Example: the Cathedral, Reales Alcazares (Royal Palaces), Casa de Pilatos, Hospital de los Venerables, Hospital de la Caridad, the Town Hall.

SHOWS


A varied selection of the most interesting shows for our students which are performed at Teatro Central, Casa de la Memoria (flamenco) and Teatro Lope de Vega.

TRIPS

Half-day to Italica, Santa Maria de las Cuevas monastery and Carmona. Full-day to Cordoba, Antequera, Ronda, Cadiz, the mountains in winter and the beach in summer (one hour from Seville). These trips take place on Saturdays and public holidays, we also offer weekend trips to Granada and Morocco.

EXCHANGES WITH LOCAL STUDENTS

Since local Spanish students also study at CLIC IH, we are able to offer an exchange programme between foreign students and local students of foreign languages. These 'intercambios' are very popular and a great way to gain further practice of Spanish outside the classroom in social contexts. Besides, our "fiestas de intercambio" are justifiably famous amongst the young people in Seville.





ACCOMMODATION

HOMESTAY (GUEST FAMILIES):

OWN APARTMENT:


Total independence for one or two
