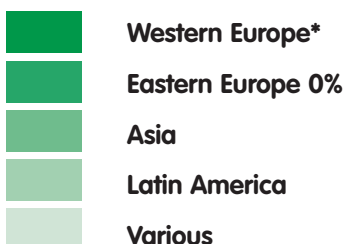
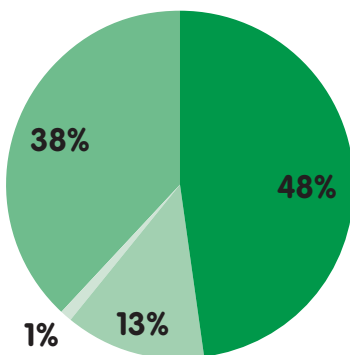
## The opinion of Eurocentres students

### Qualifications

- > Minimum age: 18 at the time of entrance to college or university
- > Language ability: Level 7 or 8 on the Eurocentres Scale at the time of entrance to college or university
- > Attendance on an extended course (min. 12 weeks) at a Eurocentres School

### The service

At regular monthly meetings at each Eurocentres, students are advised which university to apply to for the course they have chosen. We recommend that students attend the meeting and start the process of their application approximately three months before the end of their course. The academic specialists in the school of your choice will give you individual help and advice to set your goal, assistance with application forms, and personal support before your interview with the university.

- > Identifying which universities are offering the course you want
- > Advising you what IELTS score you will need for that course at the college or university concerned
- > Completing applications with you
- > Helping you organize the required supporting documentation and references
- > Ensuring your application is submitted to the right people at the right time
- > Preparation for interviews at university

## Host families are carefully selected and monitored

We have been working with most of our host families for many years now; there are families with or without children, older couples or single persons. All are experienced in looking after guests in their own homes, and all of them enjoy the opportunity of meeting people from all over the world.

## Student residence

In a student residence, the emphasis is on contact between students from all over the world. One thing is for sure, here too you'll be able to chat with each other in your foreign language outside the classroom. You'll soon make friends with other students, spending your leisure time or learning together. You'll be living in a single room, and be responsible for your own meals.
